

Tuesday, October 13, 2009 the Jasper County Board of Supervisors met in regular session at 9:30 a.m. with Supervisors Tiedje, Parsons and Stevenson present and accounted for; Chairman Tiedje presiding.

Motion by Stevenson, seconded by Parsons to amend the agenda to include a discussion with Schneider Corporation and Vanguard Co. concerning GIS web site hosting.

Joe Pugel was before the Board to discuss his personal situation with Alliant Energy in which the energy company did not recognize the fact that he had signed an agreement with Southern Iowa utilities to have underground electric cable on his property instead of overhead power poles.

Motion by Stevenson, seconded by Parsons to approve writing a letter of support for Pugel's position concerning the Alliant Energy's placement of overhead power poles on his property instead of using the existing under ground cable.

County Engineer, Jim Christensen, asked the Board to approve an agreement with Central Iowa Regional Transportation Planning Alliance (CIRTPA) to participate in the traffic counting program.

Motion by Parsons, seconded by Stevenson to approve the agreement between CIRTPA and Jasper County to purchase four pieces of traffic counting equipment with Jasper County's share of the base being \$295.00.

Christensen also asked the Board to allow for the re-classification of a portion of @84th St S from a "B" level road to a "C" level road. Christensen said that the road was a dirt road with a 15 ton limit bridge on it. Land owners on both sides of the road were in agreement with the classification change.

Motion by Parsons, seconded by Stevenson to adopt Resolution 09-43 to re-classify a portion of West 84th Street South from 76th Avenue West, north 3,801 feet to the end of the dirt portion of roadway, lying between Section 32 and 33 of 79-N20W in Mound Prairie Township to a level "C" road.

County Treasurer, Doug Bishop asked the Board to approve the cancelled check list. There are checks written by Jasper County to another party who has failed to cash their check. The total amount of \$2,290.90 will go back into the County's general fund,
