We will accept gun permit applications via US Mail (Jasper County Sheriff's Office, 2300 Law Center Drive, Newton, IA 50208) OR via our drop box in the atrium lobby of the Sheriff's Office. We must have certain documents before paperwork can be processed.

NEW PERMITS TO CARRY WEAPONS applications

- COMPLETED application
 - Be sure all blanks are filled and questions answered
 - Applications for permits to carry can be found here:

- Photocopy of your DRIVER'S LICENSE OR STATE ISSUED ID
 - Must have your CURRENT ADDRESS on your license or ID
- Photocopy of your TRAINING CERTIFICATE or MILITARY DD-214
- CHECK FOR \$50, (do not leave cash in drop box and do not send cash through the mail)
- NOTE: A Permit to Carry also enables you to purchase weapons.

NEW PERMITS TO PURCHASE WEAPONS applications

- Photocopy of your DRIVER'S LICENSE OR STATE ISSUED ID
 - Must have your CURRENT ADDRESS on your license or ID
- CHECK FOR \$40 (for 5 year permit), (do not leave cash in drop box and do not send cash through the mail)

RENEWALS of Permits to Carry or Permits to Purchase

At this time the Governor has advised these permits will not expire during this declaration.

SEX OFFENDER REGISTRY

The Department of Public Safety has advised that Registered Sex Offenders may update their registries over the phone at this time. You must speak directly to a Sheriff's Civil Office staff member, so you may answer questions we might have. Do not leave a message. Please call 641-841-1203 to register. This only applies to those whose month it is to register or those who have updates to their information.

The Sheriff's Office will be conducting random home checks on Sex Offenders during this time.

PAPER SERVICE

Most paper service has been delayed due to the courts closing. At this time, we will only be serving papers that are timely. You may call our Civil Office Staff with questions. 641-792-5912.

JAIL UPDATES

We will not be accepting any inmate property from the public nor will we be releasing any inmate property until further notice.
