 Maximum dimensions and weight allowed on an annual oversize permit are:  
 \* 120' long x 12'5" wide x 13'10" high -- unlimited distance -- no routing required  
 \* 120' long x 14'6" wide x 15'5" high -- movement restricted to 50 miles radius unless the route continues on at least 4-lane roads or trip routes are obtained from Motor Carrier Services.  
 \* 120' long x 16' wide x 15'5" high -- trip routes must be obtained  
 \* 75' long x 12'5" wide x 13'6" high -- maximum dimensions for hauling hay.  
 Carrier will be responsible for obtaining necessary route approval prior to move.

Axle spacing must conform with the formula defined in Iowa Code Section 321.463, except as provided for S.M.E. and soil conservation trailers in 321E.7(2) and 321E.7(3).

Maximum gross weight of vehicle and load allowed is 80,000 lbs. (Includes tolerances).

Speed shall not exceed \_\_\_\_\_ mph.

Speed for mobile homes shall not exceed \_\_\_\_\_ mph.

Necessary city and state permits must be obtained separately.

Permits can be issued only for transporting, single articles that exceed statutory size unless the inclusion of additional articles does not cause the size or weight to further exceed the statutory limits.
