

**Jasper County Jail**  
**School Release Privilege Rules – For the Driver of a School Release Inmate**

You must review these rules, initial each paragraph if you understand the rule and then sign at the bottom of this form before a notary public acknowledging that you will abide by these rules. These rules must be signed by the person who will be doing the driving and your signature must be notarized to be valid.

At the continuing discretion of the Sheriff, some model sentenced prisoners may be allowed to participate in the Jasper County Jail school release program. The inmate must be enrolled in school prior to starting the jail time to qualify. The inmate must follow the Sheriff's school release rules, all laws and the applicable jail conduct rules to be granted school release. School release is wholly at the discretion of the Sheriff under the Sheriff's rules but must be approved and authorized by the Court.

\_\_\_\_\_ 1 > I understand that I am transporting a prisoner of the Jasper County Jail. I understand that school release is a privilege. The Sheriff or designee may revoke school release or my ability to transport the inmate at any time in their sole discretion.

\_\_\_\_\_ 2 > A school release inmate is allowed to be out of the jail for a maximum of 12 hours per day, including travel time. Inmates are not allowed to go to school more than five (5) days out of every seven (7). I understand that any violation of the maximum 12 hour rule may result in the inmate's school release being revoked.

\_\_\_\_\_ 3 > I understand that I must transport the inmate directly from jail to school and back to jail, without excuse or exception. I understand that I cannot consume any alcohol or other non-prescribed drugs at any time covered by this agreement. I cannot take an inmate to any location where alcohol or other drugs may be found. I understand that I am subject to alcohol testing and/or drug screening (normally by urinalysis) when I pickup or deliver the school release inmate at the jail. I hereby consent to such testing/screening as an absolute condition to participate as a driver for a school released inmate. I understand that if I am found to be in possession of or having consumed alcohol or other drugs that my privilege to transport an inmate is automatically revoked. I may be charged with a crime if found to possess controlled substances or if I test positive for consumption of alcohol or controlled substances.

\_\_\_\_\_ 4 > I understand that the inmate is not allowed to go into any business. If I need to fuel my vehicle I must do so before picking up the school release inmate. I cannot pay at the pump with an inmate in my vehicle. If I violate this rule then the inmate will lose their school release and I could be criminally charged if laws apply.

\_\_\_\_\_ 5 > I understand that I may provide a meal for the inmate I am transporting, but I must pick up the food before the inmate is in my vehicle. I understand that I cannot stop for food or drink while the school release inmate is in my vehicle. If I do stop for food or drink then the inmate will lose their school release and I could be criminally charged if laws apply.

\_\_\_\_\_ 6 > I understand that I must transport the inmate directly from the Jasper County Jail to their school and directly back from school to the Jasper County Jail without delay or stopping at any other place. I cannot take the school release inmate to their home. I cannot take the school release inmate to my home or any other person's home. If I violate this rule then the inmate will lose their school release and I could be criminally charged if laws apply. I understand that the school release inmate may also be charged.

\_\_\_\_\_ 7 > If I am found to be providing false information to law enforcement to protect a work release inmate who is not following the school release rules, or who is using drugs or alcohol at school, or who is not going to school when and how they are supposed to, or are in any other way violating their school release rules, that I can be charged criminally. I understand that if the school release inmate does violate any of the Sheriff's school release rules the school release inmate may be charged criminally as well.

**If the form is not signed and notarized it is not valid and you will not be allowed to transport the inmate.**
